



Partners in Prosperity (PnP) was founded in 1998 with an objective to help poor communities to be self-reliant and evolve out of the poverty cycle. ICSD-Intercooperation Social Development India (<http://www.intercooperation.org.in>), a Section 8 Company engaged in improving the livelihoods of rural communities in India is now transiting to PnP. Together, we shall our vision of inclusive, gender sensitive and sustainably developed India. Our average annual turnover in the last three years is INR 9.30 crores. The PnP team had successfully launched a number of interventions in the states of Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh, and in and around the National Capital Region of Delhi. Interventions include access to safe water and sanitation, social and financial inclusion of ultra-poor clients, vocational training for the youth, financial literacy for improved money management among poor, promotion of self-help group, and a more holistic Ultra Poor Program.

Partners in Prosperity's (PnP) rationale for existence is to help poor communities build their own power, achieve self-reliance and permanently move from the margin to the mainstream of the development process. It is currently implementing a post flood rehabilitation programme in Kerala with funding from Swiss Solidarity and Helvetas Swiss Intercooperation
